Conference Grants for Research Master Students

- Maximum is 500 Euro.
- Deadlines for applications: 1 May and 1 December

Research Master students are encouraged to participate in international conferences. To stimulate this participation, the Graduate School of Humanities awards several Conference Grants over the year. Students who wish to be considered for such a grant are asked to submit a proposal to Moniek Lijster (m.lijster@uu.nl).

Guidelines for proposals

- **Please note that applicants who do not present at a conference do not qualify for a grant.**
- Name of the student
- Name of the student's supervisor
- Start date of research master and overview of results
- Type of contribution to the conference and status:
 - for instance: is it a research conference or a graduate conference/Arbeitsgespräch?
 - for instance: a paper or a poster session?
 - is the contribution based on the Master's thesis or on a paper written for a research seminar (or otherwise)?
 - is the contribution initiated by the student him-/herself or by the professor?
 - is there a selection or is every contribution to the conference accepted?
 - in case of a selection: is the contribution accepted?
 - in case of a selection: how difficult is it to get a paper or other contribution selected? Is about 25%, 50%, 75% or 90% selected? (a statement by the PROFESSOR/SUPERVISOR of the student about this aspect has to be included in the application)
 - what is the status of this conference? (a statement by the PROFESSOR/SUPERVISOR of the student about this aspect has to be included in the application)
- Budget

Note that the Research Director relevant to your Research Master will be consulted for the evaluation and ranking of the proposals.
