### **A safe start on location**

We think it is very important to start teaching on location in a safe way. Will you be following lessons on location soon? Then we would like to ask you to take a good look at the [basic rules](#) and [house rules](#) that apply to all students. We would also like to inform you about a number of **additional agreements** that apply to all the education at our faculty:

- Always keep a 1.5 metre distance from the lecturer. An exception can only be made if the setting really does not allow it.
- Sit apart from each other as much as possible in the classroom or lecture hall.
- Make sure you keep enough distance from each other, especially when entering and leaving the classroom.
- Do not remove your face mask until you are seated in the classroom or lecture hall.
- Feel free to keep your face mask on during lessons.
- Do not linger in the corridors after class.
- The ventilation in the buildings complies with the RIVM guidelines; where possible the lecturer will provide extra ventilation by opening windows and doors.
- Please note that lecturers may make additional arrangements for the education they provide.

### **Symptoms and illness**

Are you experiencing symptoms of the coronavirus such as coughing, a cold, sore throat, fever and/or loss of smell or taste? Stay at home and get tested (also with mild symptoms).
