<p>Honours thesis: general</p> <p>Does the thesis meet the additional requirements for an Honours thesis? <p>1 Depth</p> <p>The ability to carry out analyses at a high level and to interpret issues within one's own field of study. Does the thesis include a challenging source/literary criticism and theoretical framework?</p>	
<p>2 Breadth</p> <p>The ability to relate issues within one's own field of study to approaches that occupy a key position in other fields within or outside the humanities. Has the chosen interdisciplinarity been substantiated theoretically?</p>	
<p>3 Social context</p> <p>The ability to place questions and insights within one's own field of study in a social context and/or to apply them in practice.</p>	
<p>(Additional category:) International context</p> <p>The ability to grasp and position questions and insights within one's own field of study in an international academic context.</p>	
<p>Autonomy</p> <p>The ability to formulate substantive questions within one's own discipline with a high degree of autonomy and to develop a critically responsible research strategy to this end.</p>
