## **PREPARATION**

#### exchange application process

The exchange application process was a complicated and intensive one. It included getting approved by UU and LU, choosing your courses (also getting those approved by the board of examiners) and then also obtaining the Erasmus grant. The most difficult part was going through the courses and understanding which ones you can or cannot choose (I didn't know that I was allowed to choose masters courses). You need to submit a lot of documents for the erasmus grant, but there are clear instructions on the UU website.

I didn't need to do any language preparations. Except for the Erasmus grant application I needed to take a language placement test for English.
