Albert Heijn (AH) / Jumbo / Plus	Supermarket (also sells pay-as-you-go phone cards)
Kruidvat / Etos	Toiletries and over the counter medication
HEMA	Has almost everything: (basic) clothes, toiletries, office supplies, bedding, kitchen stuff, decorations for your room, pay-as-you-go phone cards
Bike shops: (For example) Fietspunt, Fietswinkel Laag	Bikes and bike supplies
SwapFiets	If you want to lease a bike
Hoog Catharijne	"The Mall"
Bruna	Office supplies, stamps, post office
