

Study Abroad Application Form

This form is an important document in the application process. It has two purposes: On the one hand we will use the information for your allocation and on the other hand you can use the form to consider how your exchange will fit into your study programme. It is very important to complete all components before uploading it in your Osiris exchange application. Without a complete form, your application will not be taken into consideration.

Pay attention to the following

- Write in English
- Stick to the maximum number of words
- This form is used only for your initial Study Abroad application in Osiris.
- This form is an indication only of the courses you would like to take while studying abroad.
- The courses abroad have to be accepted as credits towards your degree in Utrecht and must be approved by the Board of Examiners of your study programme as soon as your course enrolment at your host university has been finalised. At this moment no approval is required yet. Check the information on your study programme's website for more details

It is strongly advised to discuss your study plan with your tutor/study advisor before submitting your application. For some UU study programmes it is even mandatory.
