



Studying with dyslexia, a disability or chronic illness

Dear student,

Are you studying with dyslexia, a disability or a chronic illness? Do you think educational arrangements or accommodations, such as extra time when sitting exams, could help you? Please let us know.

This can be done starting from July 1st via Osiris Cases*. Indicate which arrangements or accommodations you think you'll need, e.g. arrangements or accommodations you have used in your previous studies. Please be aware that arrangements or accommodations at UU might differ from what you're used to at your previous educational institution. You can also upload the required (medical) statement/diagnosis via Osiris Cases. All data will be treated confidentially and your uploaded statement/diagnosis will be automatically deleted after two months.

Once you have submitted your data and it has been deemed complete, you'll receive a confirmation via your student's email address with the possibility of making an appointment with a study advisor.

Arrangements or accommodations will be granted *provisionally* as soon as possible after the application is made. The study advisor will then discuss with you during the above-mentioned appointment which arrangements or accommodations will be definitively granted.

If you submit your data in Osiris Case no later than **Sunday, September 8th**, we can guarantee that you will be able to use the arrangements or accommodations during the first exam period. This is only the deadline for submitting your request via Osiris Cases, it is not necessary that you already have had an appointment. Do try to schedule the appointment as soon as you receive the confirmation.
