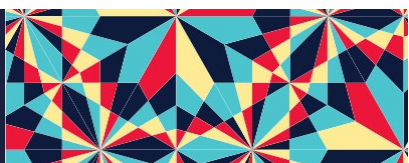
Part 1: Motivation

Below are three questions for you to answer. They are reflection questions: there is no 'right' or 'wrong' answer. They are just an invitation to share your thoughts and experiences. You could use the sub-questions below each question to guide your answer. Respond to each question in **max 200 words** in the text box below.

Question 1

Why are you applying to Navigating Insecure Futures?

How does this specific programme connect to you, your studies, work, and other activities? Why do you feel you need to be part of it? What kind of things do you envision to learn?





Question 2

Who are you?

How would you describe yourself? Could you give examples of experiences, traditions, and/or values that shaped you? How do you experience your own position within society and/or a group? How do you relate to differences in culture, background, and societal status?





Question 3

Why do you believe you have the capacity, time, and commitment to participate in this programme?

How does this programme fit into your life? Why will you prioritize it over other things that you could be spending your time on? How much time, attention and energy would you have for it? Are there balances that you will have to keep in mind, for instance between working hours, grades, and leisure?

What are (some of) your narratives, stories, or images of the future? Are they hopeful, fearful, boring, or adventurous? Are they small-scale or large-scale? Which communities, people, entities are featured in them? Who are not? What is your role in them?

It does not have to offer any kind of academic discussion, problem analysis, or solution – just how you are seeing (part of) the future is enough. We will ask you to present this page during the intake session, so please check with yourself what you are comfortable sharing with others. Make sure to bring it there either in physical form or digitally.
