


Search Manual for the [UU course catalogue](#)

1. Check whether you're searching in the intended academic year (2020 stands for 2020-2021)
2. Find courses in one specific teaching period to refine your selection or prevent getting too many results.
Fill in for Teaching period in which the course begins: 1 etc.
Your selection returns too many results. Only 200 results can be shown. Please refine your selection to see other courses.
3. Find courses within one faculty.
Fill in for Faculty: of Humanities, or the other faculty you wish to search.
4. Find courses within a part of the Faculty of Humanities (a so-called *School*).
Choose one of the following options for School / Programme (Ug stands for Undergraduate):
 - Ug School Filosofie en religiewetenschap = Philosophy and Religion sciences
 - Ug School Geschiedenis en kunstgeschiedenis = History and Art history
 - Ug School Liberal arts
 - Ug School Media en Cultuurwetenschappen = Media and Culture sciences
 - Ug School Talen, Literatuur en Communicatie = Languages, Literature and Communication
5. Find courses on 1 specific level 1, 2 of 3.
Fill in for Category / Level:
 - Bachelor Introductory (level 1)
 - Bachelor Elaborating (level 2)
 - Bachelor Advanced (level 3)
6. Find courses from another faculty.
Choose the right faculty and choose 'Yes' in the field Student taking subsidiary courses.
7. Find courses currently open for registration.
In the field Course module/name > Show, you mark the option 'Course modules for which you can register' (see illustration below).
NOTE! Due to imperfections of Osiris, courses with priority rules are shown until the end of the course registration period for blocks 1 and 2 (or blocks 3 and 4), even when the (shortened) registration period for these courses is already closed. Therefore always check the Remark-field of the course description to see if there are special rules applied.
8. Find courses by searching in the Title or with Keywords / use wildcard.
When you want to expand your search by searching in the full course description, place a checkmark at 'Also search in description' (see illustration below).
The %-symbol may be used as a wildcard.
