Advantages of choosing Europe – part 1

- Financial: availability of grants & scholarships
 - Erasmus+ study grant
- Options for sustainable travel (bus and train)
 - Travel Green Grant





Erasmus+ grant for studies

- For all destinations in the EU + EEA (Iceland, Norway & Turkey)
- Grant amounts vary between € 270 and 390 a month
- Erasmus+ top-ups: green travel top-up, top-up for fewer opportunities
- Students will be informed about application before summer of 2024

How?

- Applications in Osiris, allocation by lottery
- TGG is for: travel to your European exchange destination by train or bus (and ferry)
- Personal budget up to 194 Euros
- Option to buy an Interrail Pass





Why?

- Save money, and the planet! (And some other considerations)

- Applications: early summer 2024

Advantages of choosing Europe – part 2

- Similar educational system using European credits (ECTS)
- No GPA requirement for UU wide EU destinations
- Erasmus Student Network for social activities
- Saving money because:
 - No need to apply for a visa
 - Covered by European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
 - Generally no IELTS or TOEFL test scores needed

1 NOVEMBER 2023	STAY ABROAD SECTION OPEN IN OSIRIS
1 DECEMBER 2023	DEADLINE FOR ALL EXCHANGE DESTINATIONS 1 ST ROUND – also for semester 2!
